Vitellus BioSM Soil Samples - Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)

FAQs	Vitellus Bio SM Soil Samples
How do I take a soil sample?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Take 10 to 20 soil cores or shovel scoops from a depth of 0-6 inches and mix in a plastic bucket • Empty bucket into A&L provide soil bag and FILL THE ENTIRE BAG • Label bag and submission sheet with desired sample name
How much sample do I need?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • To complete both the Vitellus Bio and Vitellus Soil Health test, please fill the A&L provided soil bag to the TOP (as we need more soil to carryout both tests which are included in the Vitellus Bio Package)
How do I send a sample?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Please label all bags and containers with grower information and sample ID • Paperwork should be included with all samples – submission paperwork can be found on www.alcanada.com • Samples can be shipped via courier to 2136 Jetstream Road, London, ON. N5V 3P5 • Samples can be dropped off Monday to Friday from 8 am to 5 pm. After hours, samples can be placed in the plastic shed located between the buildings
Do I need to do anything special to the sample for shipping?	For Vitellus Bio, shipping samples on the same day through overnight courier will be preferable. Storing samples longer than a day, allowing to dry out, and freezing should be avoided, as all these will potentially affect the microbial population.
How long will it take to get my results?	Vitellus Bio results will be available in 7 business days of the lab receiving the samples.
How can I access my previous tests?	Results will be emailed to email contacts on the account submitting the sample. Previous results can be accessed through A&L's Dataweb using your account number.
